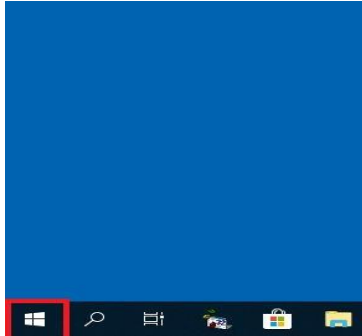


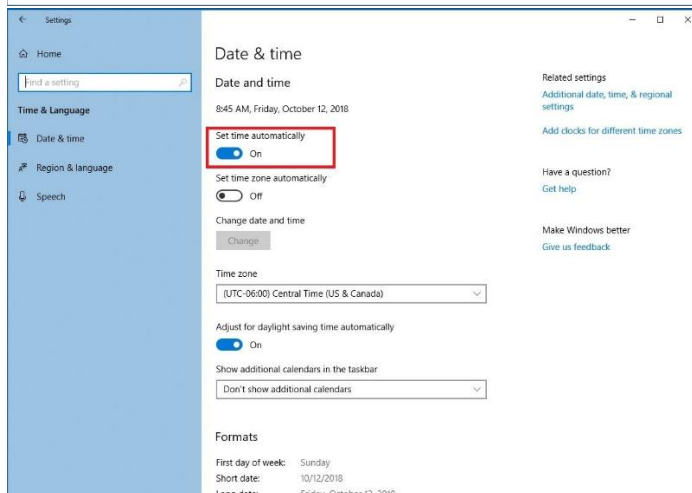
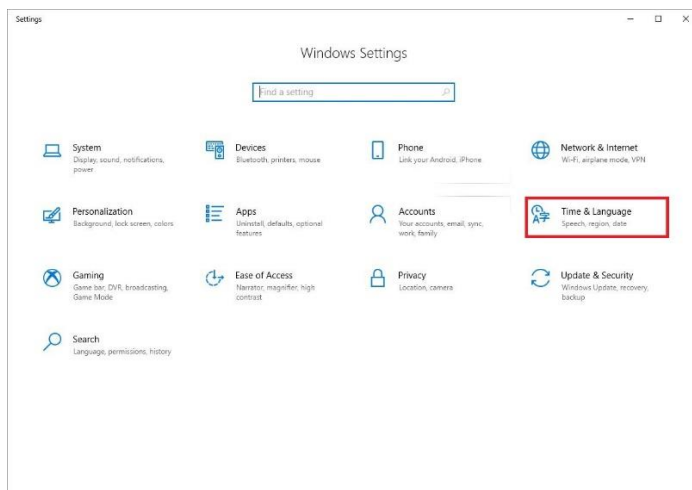
Updating Date/Time (Windows 10)

Step 1 – Select your Windows start button located in the lower left hand corner of the screen to open up your start menu.



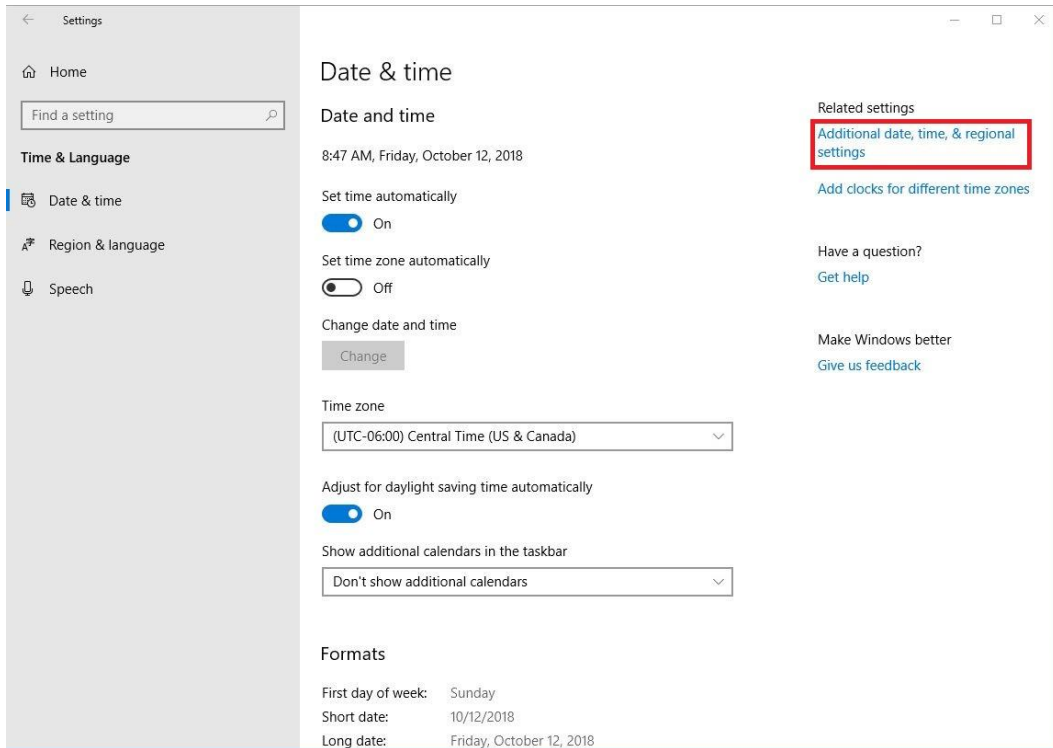
Step 2 – From here, you will then want to select the gear/cog button just above the windows start button to open your **Settings**.

Step 3 – You will then want to select **Time & Language** and turn off **Set time automatically** before turning this setting back on.

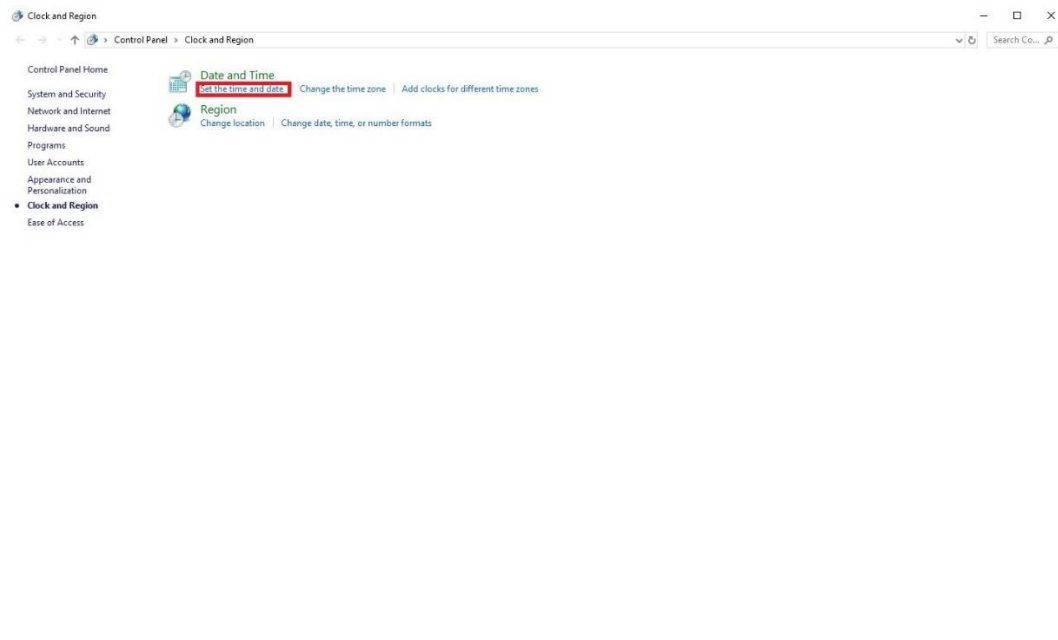


Step 4 – After following these steps, you will then want to relaunch GNT and make sure that you are not notified of any time discrepancies upon syncing. If you are not met with any error messages, you are free to continue using the program.

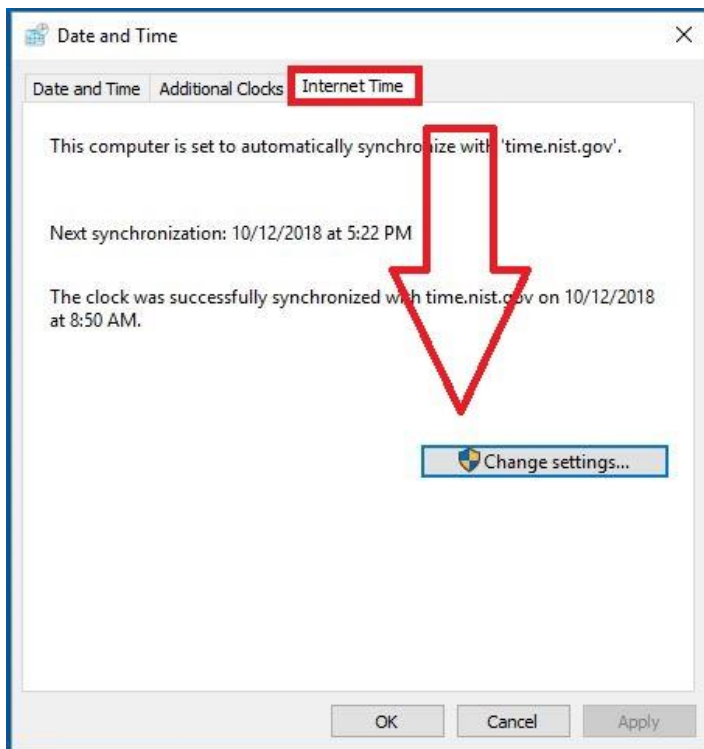
Opt. Step 5 – If your time error persists, you will want to select **Additional date, time, regional settings** from the upper right hand corner of the Date & Time settings window.



Step 6 – From here, you will want to select **Set the time and date** located under Date and Time.



Step 7 – Select **Internet Time** from the tabs within this window and select **Change Settings** to bring up the Internet Time Settings form.



Step 8 – Lastly, you will want to select **Update Now** located next to the Server dropdown box to reset your internet time before relaunching GNT to see if you are met with any time discrepancies upon syncing.
